

Scottish Rite Orthosis

The Scottish Rite orthosis consists of a metal pelvic band attached with hip joints to two thigh cuffs. This is a custom orthosis used to keep the hips in abduction (spread apart).

Indications:

- Post surgical positioning and management of Legg-Calve-Perthes disease, developmental dysplasia, and other hip pathologies that require some movement while maintaining hip abduction.



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
